- Intend to have a career in production agriculture or agribusiness.
- Select a major preference in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources:
  - Agribusiness Management
  - Agriculture and Natural Resources Communication
  - Food Industry Management
  - Agriscience
  - Animal Science
  - Crop & Soil Sciences
  - Horticulture
- Complete an application form including a short narrative.

- Application must be received by or postmarked by June 1.
