

GreenStone Sponsors Scholarships to Michigan State University Upper and Lower Peninsula of Michigan Only

GreenStone FCS gives five \$2,000 scholarships to deserving incoming freshmen who have applied to the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources at MSU.

To be considered for a GreenStone scholarship, a student must:

- Be a graduate of a Michigan high school
- Be an incoming MSU freshman
- Have at least a 3.0 high school grade point average
- Demonstrate leadership skills and community involvement through activities such as FFA, 4-H, and other organizations
- Intend to have a career in production agriculture or agribusiness
- Select a major preference in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources:
 - Agribusiness Management
 - Agriculture and Natural Resources Communication
 - Food Industry Management
 - Agriscience
 - Animal Science
 - Crop & Soil Sciences
 - Horticulture
- Complete an application and essay.
- Be familiar with GreenStone Farm Credit Services

Scholarship applications will be sent automatically to students who have applied to MSU and have indicated an interest in the College of Ag and Natural Resources. If “no preference” is listed as a major, a scholarship application will not be sent. The application form must be received by MSU or postmarked by April 15.
