At the suggestion of members, GreenStone Farm Credit Services' legislative engagement began in earnest in 2010 to advocate for vibrant rural communities and farms, and a strong Farm Credit System. Political Action Committees (PACs) are a part of that strategy to accomplish this mission through relationship building. The PACs provide modest, direct financial support to elected officials and candidates to encourage support for rural communities, agriculture, and Farm Credit.

At GreenStone, there are three PACs: Farm Credit PAC, MI GreenStone PAC, and WI Farm Credit PAC.

The Farm Credit PAC is governed by elected borrower members from across the U.S. Farm Credit System with input from the GreenStone Board of Directors with its Legislative/Public Policy Committee. Financial support for the Farm Credit PAC is from Association directors and employees, and it is directed to members of the U.S. Congress.

The MI GreenStone PAC and WI Farm Credit PAC are governed by the GreenStone Board of Directors with its Legislative/Public Policy Committee. Its financial resources come from Farm Credit members in Michigan and Wisconsin and are supplemented by directors and employees. These funds are directed to the state's legislative members.
