Measuring instructions:

- 1. Measure the inside spread of the main beams of the antlers straight across at its widest point. This would be measurement "D" in *Diagram 1* below. Measure it to the nearest one-eighth inch and record this measurement on line one above.
- 2. Count the number of points on the antlers that are longer than 1 inch. See *Diagram 2* for measuring points longer than 1 inch. Record the number of points on line two above.
- 3. Add the inches of inside spread (nearest one-eighth inch) and number of points together and record on line three above. This is the total score.

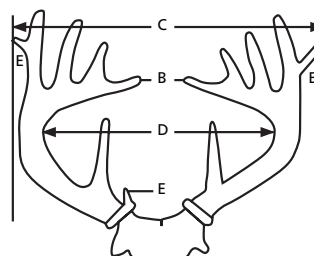
