DAVE ARMSTRONG SCHOLARSHIP



In honor of former President and CEO, Dave Armstrong, GreenStone Farm Credit Services will award up to \$20,000 in scholarships to college students in the amount of \$5,000 each. Dave Armstrong served GreenStone and the agricultural community for 41 years before retiring in 2022. Like GreenStone, Dave values youth development and continued education, supporting the future success of agriculture and timber.

APPLICATION AND DETAILS

Part 1: Student to Complete

- Visit www.greenstonefcs.com/scholarships to access and download the application.
- Once downloaded, save as Your Full Name – Scholarship 2026. Once your file has been saved, open and complete the Personal Information, Questions and Consent Release sections (page 1 -3).
- Once you have completed pages 1-3, re-save your application.

Part 2: Evaluator to Complete

- Student must email entire application package to a non-family member for evaluation and completion of the Reference Form (page 4).
- Once complete, evaluator shall email the entire application package back to student.

Part 3: Student Submits Application

- Once all sections are complete, submit entire application package, a current, one-page resume providing details on work experience, extracurricular activities, leadership positions, awards and other relevant experiences gained during college along with a copy of the student's transcripts.
- The completed application must be returned by March 1, 2026 to GreenStone Farm Credit Services by email: marketing@greenstonefcs.com.

Additional Details

- Applications will be reviewed by the GreenStone Farm Credit Services scholarship committee and notification will be provided to applicants on or before April 1, 2026.
- If selected, a course schedule of the Fall 2026 semester at the same college or university, with the same field of study as listed on scholarship application, must be received by August 1, 2026 It is the recipient's responsibility to forward the confirmed class schedule to GreenStone Farm Credit Services by August 1, 2026, or risk forfeit of scholarship.
- After August 1, 2026, scholarship award funds will be mailed by check directly to the admissions office of the student's college or university following receipt of course schedule.
- In the event any portion of the funding is not used by recipient for the sole purpose of higher education, the unused portion shall be returned to GreenStone.

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QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must meet the following qualifications in order to be considered for a GreenStone Farm Credit Services scholarship:

- Open to current college students majoring in an agricultural or timber-related field with at least the fall semester (minimum 12 credit hours) remaining in the year of application.
- Must be a resident within GreenStone Farm Credit Services' territory, which includes Michigan and these Wisconsin counties: Brown, Door, Florence, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marinette, Menominee, Oconto, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca.
- Preference will be given to those attending a Michigan or Wisconsin college or university.
- Currently studying an agriculture or timber-related field.
- Student must be currently enrolled as a full time college student (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester).
- Intend to have a career in production agriculture, agribusiness or timber.
- Demonstrates participation and leadership in school, community and agricultural/timber activities.
- Preference will be given to students with a 3.0 or higher college grade point average.
- Provide a current, one-page resume providing details on college-only work experience, extracurricular activities, leadership positions, awards and other relevant information.
- Submit a transcript from your college or university showing current Spring semester courses; unofficial transcripts are acceptable.
- Include one reference form completed by a non-family member.
- Relatives (siblings, stepsiblings, children, stepchildren, grandchildren, step-grandchildren, nieces and nephews) of GreenStone Farm Credit Services board director and employees are not eligible to receive a scholarship.

* * Preference will be given to first time applicants of the Dave Armstrong Scholarship.
